This memorandum of understanding (MoU) is made on this the ...23...day of May, 2019 at Dehradun between the Conservator of Forest (Research Wing), Forest Department, Government of Uttarakhand herein after referred as 'First Party'

AND

Officer In-charge, Botanical Survey of India, NRC, Dehradun, Ministry of Environment Forest and Climate Change, Government of India, herein after referred as 'Second Party'

WHEREAS the first party is Government Department engaged in the research and conservation of flora and fauna in the State of Uttarakhand.


WHEREAS the Second Party is a scientific institution of Central Government under the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, Government of India, established to survey and document the plant resources of the country and also to provide the advisory services to the Ministry and other organizations.

Both the parties are interested in promoting scientific research on threatened species and their in-situ and ex-situ conservation.


Therefore, both the parties agreed hereunder as follows:

1. First Party will facilitate the logistic support in research of species found in Uttarakhand Forest and will provide appropriate space in their nurseries and experiment sites for experiment related to threatened species and their rehabilitation .
2. Second Party will provide the technical support to the First Party particularly in identification of species, phytogeographical distribution of species, IUCN status of the species and other advisory services, so that the First Party truly can implement/propagate those species which are really dwindling from the nature and facing the threat of extinction. Second Party will also provide the saplings of the threatened species available with them for the rehabilitation in the wild under the species recovery programme.
3. Both the parties will complete their commitments/duties in a time bound manner in best possible way so as to facilitate objective of conservation of threatened species of Uttarakhand in most efficacious and expeditious manner.
4. On the submission/publication of report by both the party to their respective agencies, the contribution of each party will be duly acknowledged.




